### **DECISION**

1. This is an appeal by Dr Spicer against the decision by the Herefordshire Primary Care Trust (the PCT) to remove him from their performers list. The ground of the removal was **unsuitability** under regulation 10(3) and 10(4)(c) of the National Health Service (Performers Lists) Regulations 2004. The decision and reasons were sent to Dr Spicer by letter dated 5 June 2009.
2. Dr Spicer appealed against the decision on 1 July 2009.
3. The Primary Health Lists Tribunal (the panel) concluded the hearing of Dr Spicer's appeal on 17 January 2011.
4. The panel has decided to **dismiss** the appeal of Dr Spicer.
5. The reasons for the decision will be made available to the parties by 14 February 2011. There will be a summary of the panel's reasons which will be made public and full reasons which will be made available to the parties only. The parties are directed to draw up a schedule of persons to whom the full reasons may be provided. This schedule to be served within seven days of receipt of reasons.
6. Within seven days of receipt of reasons the parties are directed to serve written submissions as to whether Dr Spicer should be made subject to a national disqualification. If either party wishes to make oral representations to the Primary Health Lists Tribunal on the matter of national disqualification then arrangements should be made with the Primary Health Lists Tribunal listing team.
